Vendor will comply with the hours of operation as prescribed. Failure to observe these hours may mean loss of privilege to sell. No sales or set backs are allowed before the market is officially opened by one the Market Manager or guest opener.

Vendor may not occupy or set up their stall until 3:45 p.m.

Vendor may not sublet their space to anyone without permission of the Market Manager.

Vendor shall offer for sale only approved items which are actually produced, manufactured or value added by the vendor in the vendor’s own garden, farm or home. The offering of sale of any item acquired from others, either for resale or consignment, is only permitted with prior approval from the Market Manager. It is assumed that each market vendor represents one farm or business and that the vendor is actively involved in that farm or business.

Organizations and groups may participate with prior approval from the Market Manager; special rules may apply.
